



CONDORS SAFETY INFORMATION

With the California Department of Public Health allowing us to open up with fans at 10% capacity, there will also be additional Arena protocols to ensure the safety of our players, coaches, staff, and fans. Please read in full the new guidelines that all fans must adhere to during the remaining games this season.

BAG POLICY

 Only CLEAR bags no larger than 12x12x6 are allowed, including purses. Clutch purses ok, but any bag purse will not be allowed unless clear.

BUILDING ENTRY

- Both the main entrance and side entrance off N Street will be welcoming fans into the building. CLOTH FACE COVERINGS
- Face coverings are required to be worn by all guests (ages 2 and up) and staff members at all times, including those who have received a COVID-19 vaccine, while inside and outside Mechanics Bank Arena. The use of face coverings is not a substitute for physical distancing.
- For the safety of guests, staff, players, and media members, guests that refuse to comply with the Mechanics Bank Arena face covering policy will be denied entry or escorted out of the building without a refund.

FOOD & BEVERAGE

- Food and Beverage will be available during games, however it must be consumed at socially distanced tables on the concourse only.
- Per California State Guidelines, no food and beverage will be allowed at your seats.
- Club Room and Tap Room will not be open.

PARKING

• All parking, including the parking garage and Arena Parking P1 will be free of charge.

POD SEATING

- All tickets are placed in 'pods' with only one group/family/party seated together. Due to social
 distancing requirements and the inability to relocate seats, fans must stay in their pod. Joining
 another pod or seating in seats that are not assigned is not allowed and will be strictly enforced.
- All tickets this season are digital. Prior to arriving to the arena, you must download the AXS App on your phone. Your tickets will be sent to your AXS account, which can be viewed on the phone and contactless scanned by Arena Ushers.

COOPER MARODY 39gp - 21g - 15a - 36pts

Marody led the AHL with 21 goals and tied for third in overall scoring with 36 points in 39 games for Bakersfield this season, his third pro campaign. A native of Brighton, Mich., Marody was an AHL All-Star as a rookie in 2018-19 and has registered 46 goals and 74 assists for 120 points in 130 career AHL contests with the Condors. Originally selected by Philadelphia in the sixth round of the 2015 NHL Draft, Marody was acquired by Edmonton on Mar. 21, 2018.

THE REGINNINGS

Embarking on its 85th season of play in 2020-21, the American Hockey League is continuing a tradition of excellence that began in 1936 when the Canadian-American Hockey League joined with the International Hockey League to form what is today known as the AHL. Eight teams hit the ice that first season, representing Buffalo, Cleveland, New

Haven, Philadelphia, Pittsburgh, Providence, Springfield and Syracuse.

Frank Calder, the National Hockey League's president at the time, was instrumental in the forming of this new league, and his name would be given to its championship trophy. The first Calder Cup was won by the Syracuse Stars in 1937; the Hershey Bears have

championships in league history with 11.

From those roots, the American Hockey League has grown into a 31-team, coast-to-coast league that provides fans with exciting, high-level professional hockey while preparing thousands of players, coaches, officials, executives, trainers, broadcasters and more for careers in the NHL.

THE PLAYERS

In today's National Hockey League nearly 90 percent of the players are AHL alumni, including 2020 Vezina Trophy winner Connor Hellebuyck, Norris Trophy recipient Roman Josi and Hart Trophy winner Leon Draisaitl. The 2020 Stanley Cup champion Tampa Bay Lightning were stocked with AHL graduates including Andrei Vasilevskiy, Nikita Kucherov, and former Calder Cup champions Ondrej Palat, Alex Killorn and Tyler Johnson.

During the 2019-20 season, a total of 866 AHL alumni played in the National Hockey League. There were 353 players who skated in both leagues last year alone, including the New York Rangers' **Igor Shesterkin**, Anaheim's **Troy Terry**, Dallas's **Joel Kiviranta** and Montreal's **Jesperi Kotkaniemi**.

In addition, more than 220 former first- and secondround NHL draft picks developed their skills in the AHL last season, including Filip Zadina, Evan Bouchard, Morgan Frost, Owen Tippett, Jack Studnicka, Josh Norris and Jake Bean.

THE LEGENDS

For the past eight decades, the American Hockey League has been home to some of the greatest players in the history of our sport. In fact, more than 100 honered members of the Hockey Hall of Fame have been affiliated with the AHL during their carees.

All-time greats like Johnny Bower, Toe Blake, Gump Worsley, Terry Sawchuk, Glenn Hall, Brad Park, Ken Dryden, and Brett Hull came through the AHL ranks and now find themselves enshrined in Toronto, and the coveted Calder Cup is inscribed with the names of legendary AHL alumni like Patrick Roy, Larry Robinson, Gerry Cheevers, Andy Bathgate, Tim Horton, Al Arbour, Emile Francis, Doug Harvey, and Billy Smith.

THE COACHES

At the start of the 2020-21 season, the National Hockey League featured 23 head coaches who were former AHL bench bosses, including 2020 Stanley Cup winner **Jon Cooper** of the Tampa Bay Lightning and 2020 Jack Adams Award recipient **Bruce Cassidy** of the Boston Bruins.

Colorado's **Jared Bednar**, Washington's **Peter Laviolette**, Pittsburgh's **Mike Sullivan**, Nashville's **John Hynes**, Vancouver's **Travis Green** and Dallas's **Rick Bowness** are also among the current NHL coaches who spent time in the American Hockey League before making the jump.

IN HIS FIRST SEASON (2018-19) BEHIND THE BENCH IN BAKERSFIELD, WOODCROFT LED THE TEAM TO ITS FIRST-EVER AHL PACIFIC DIVISION TITLE, REGULAR SEASON WESTERN CONFERENCE TITLE, AHL CALDER CUP PLAYOFFS BERTH, AND CALDER CUP PLAYOFFS SERIES VICTORY. THE TEAM'S 42 WINS WERE THE MOST-EVER FOR THE CONDORS ORGANIZATION. DURING THE SEASON, THE TEAM WON 17 CONSECUTIVE GAMES, ALL IN REGULATION OR OVERTIME, TIED FOR THE SECOND LONGEST STREAK IN AHL HISTORY.
